Why do you have to move out of a tent in a lightning storm? Because it's a conductor and tents aren't grounded and you could get electrocuted.

How long do you have to wait after the last lightning boom? Wait 30 minutes...

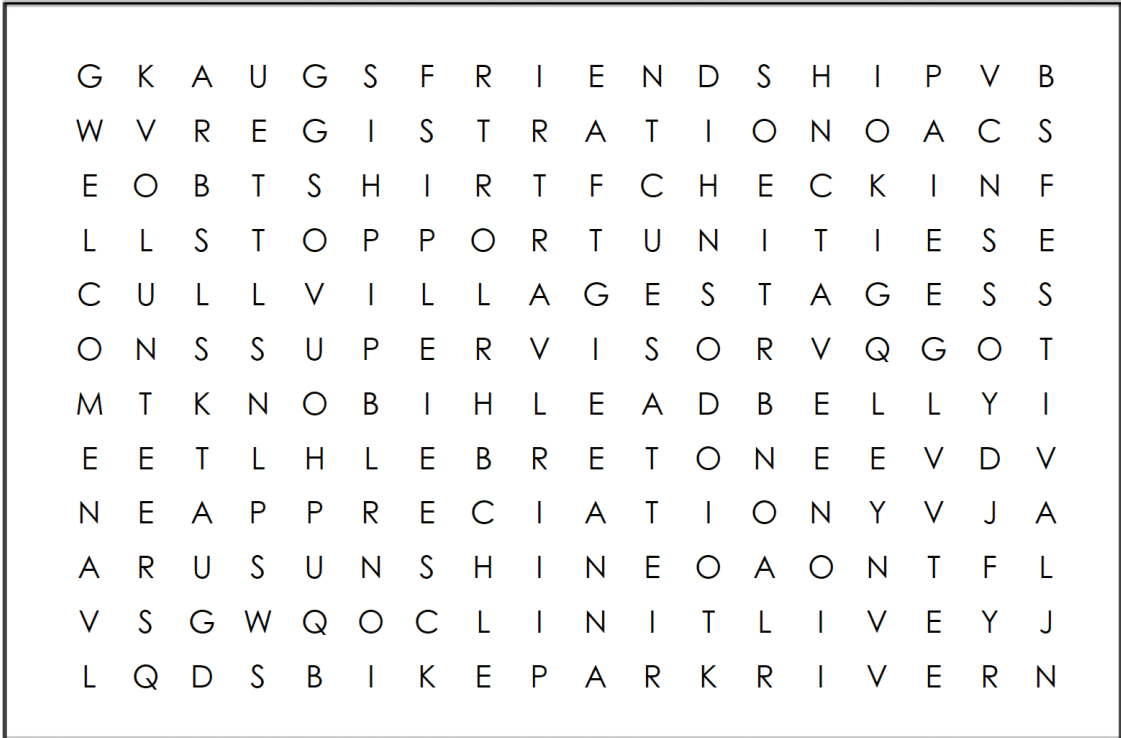
You shouldn't go back out until the last strike was 15 kms 20 mins later.

If an emergency of a grand scale occurs, volunteers who are on shift may be instructed to:

- A** If premises must be vacated, volunteers are to meet their Area Leader and/or Assistant in the LeBreton Gallery inside the War Museum.
- B** If LeBreton Gallery is not an option for our team to gather at, (i.e., unsafe, unavailable due to the nature of emergency, etc.) then volunteers are to gather in Volunteer Village
- C** If your team has access to a trailer or atelier then that will act as an additional evacuation point
