The Signage team is a small but important group of volunteers that do mostly pre- and post-festival work installing and removing signage throughout the festival grounds.

Duties:

- install signage prior to the festival
- put up appropriate sponsor signs before each sponsored stage event and remove them after
- ensure signage is secure during festival
- remove signage after the festival
- perform an inventory of signs after festival to ensure that they are ready for following year

Requirements:

- must be 15 years of age or older
- Accessibility Standards Customer Service Training
- this position requires individuals to be enthusiastic & energetic
- must work efficiently with or without direct supervision
- the success of volunteers in this position depends on their ability to follow very specific instructions
- willing to work in all types of weather
- some lifting of and carrying small loads will be required

Skills:

- able to troubleshoot problems
- effective communication skills
- exceptional attention to detail

Assets:

- valid driver's license
- Bilingualism

Equipment Required:

 Hard Hat, Steel Toe Shoes/Boots and High Visibility Safety Vest required during set-up and tear-down shifts while the festival site is considered a construction zone.
