<p>Duties:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collect & sort recycling, compost and garbage containers throughout the site • support the overall goal of Green Team by engaging festival volunteers and answering questions about Ottawa Bluesfest's new environmental strategies • encourage people to use the new waste reduction facilities, such as recycling bins • perform duties regardless of weather conditions 	<p>Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • must be 15 years of age or over • Accessibility Standards Customer Service Training • this position requires individuals to be energetic & motivated • must work efficiently in teams of 2-3 with little to no direct supervision • must wear non-slip, closed-toed shoes (e.g. runners) • must bring appropriate clothing and footwear for all types of weather (e.g. sun, rain, wind) • able to maneuver site with minimal assistance (this position is accessible to people with a variety of mobility differences) • Must work in all types of weather • willing to stand for long periods of time • some heavy lifting will be required.
