If the answer is **'Optional'**, it means that there are certain roles that do not require a volunteer to do the specified action in the specified Crew. If the answer is **'No'**, it means that the specified action does not apply to the specified Crew.

Gates volunteers are required to have spoken interactions with the public at the same time as using scanners. This makes the area challenging for volunteers with hearing difficulties or developmental disabilities. Not impossible, but challenging and sometimes frustrating for those volunteers.
