Floaters are a special group of 18+ volunteers who act as support for just about all other areas on site! As a result of this, it is possible that you could be placed in a number of different areas, with different requirements, that operate in different environments during the festival. The Floaters will have their home base inside the museum, but volunteers will likely be deployed all over the festival site.
