This team helps fill the gaps on other teams when they need extra support. You'll get to try a variety of experiences – a great first time volunteer role!

Alternates are assigned tasks based on the requirements of the festival. These tasks could include, but are not limited to, beverage service, inventory control, info booth, silent auction, and volunteer trailer. Volunteers sign up for pre-set shifts and are assigned to an area on an as-needed basis.

Please Note: Wait times for an assignment will vary, and in some cases, volunteers may not receive an assignment during their shift; if the latter happens, the volunteer will still receive credit for their shift. Volunteers should come to every shift prepared to either work or wait (having a good book or an electronic device is allowed while volunteers wait).
