Or are you an extrovert looking to spend part of the evening ensuring our patrons are getting to and from the stage for their favourite artists safely?*

*If so and you are 18+ years of age with a valid driver's license, Road Warriors might be the right team for you!*

The Road Warriors are a specialized team of volunteers that are first and foremost responsible for ensuring the safety of our patrons, staff, volunteers, and authorized personal. As the festivals has evolved over the years, our main roadway (Vimy Place) which runs right down the middle of the LeBreton Flats Park became a challenge. This team was formed to overcome those challenges. When done correctly we are crucial to ensuring each person on site has a positive festival experience. As a team, we have to be alert, easily visible, and in constant communication with our fellow team members and festival patrons.

Duties in this area are slightly varied and will be assigned by a supervisor on a shift-by-shift basis.
